



Thank you for your interest in 151 Enterprises. We are dedicated to furthering our vision of unifying our society through the use of urban farming. Our mission is one that relies on blending traditional and medical cannabis crops along with the industries that support them through affiliate and subsidiary businesses. Here is a list of those businesses with a brief description as to how they function;

151 Farmers: These are franchise farms that operate in a non-profit status to cultivate 1 pound of cannabis to 5 pounds of food to 1 community. 151 Farmers are dedicated to growing those crops organically with the minimum impact on our environment. Through the use of aquaponics systems we improve crop qualities while reducing water consumption to less than 10% of the water used in traditional crop cultivation. In addition to the co-cultivation of the fish we are able to successfully grow a wide variety of lettuce types, macro-algae and hops for the local breweries.



151 Mart: Licensed retail dispensaries that promote organic cannabis products.

151 Distribution: Licensed CA wholesale distributor of cannabis products.

151 Manufacturing: Licensed manufacturing of cannabis concentrates edibles and capsules.

151 Sciences: The science of cannabis and our understanding of the human endocannabinoid system are only improved when the plant materials are coming from stable genetics having been organically grown under optimum environmental conditions and in repeatable values. The scientists and researchers who work in these labs work with the cultivators in the development of genetics for specific conditions, tissue culturing and the cataloguing of those genetics.

151 Security: Provides contracted real time 'Eye on Monitoring' video surveillance utilizing mobile wireless and solar powered surveillance equipment that can be easily deployed and setup we assist local law enforcement in maintaining community, customer and employee site integrity and safety.

151 Financial: As per recreational cannabis law under Prop 64 in California, beginning in January 2018 newly licensed cannabis farmers will require surety bonds. We provide those surety bonds as well as financing options for those cannabis related businesses that require real estate or equipment financing.
