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SYNOPSIS:

On 06/10/2017, at approximately 1049 hours, 3 to 4 black males entered the IND-GRO marijuana dispensary located at 6176 Federal Blvd and robbed Jeffrey HAGLER at gunpoint. The suspects tied HAGLER up with duct tape and took cash from his wallet. Additionally, they took multiple bags of finished product (marijuana) from the office.

There were multiple witnesses to his incident.

The estimated value of the marijuana that was stolen is between \$16,000 to \$18,000 dollars. Additionally, \$280 in cash was stolen from Jeffrey HAGLER'S wallet.

ORIGIN:

On 06/10/2017, at approximately 1049 hours, I received a radio call regarding robbery in progress at the IND-GRO marijuana dispensary, which is located at 6176 Federal Avenue. The reporting party was Darrel COTTON, who is also the owner of the dispensary. COTTON advised police dispatchers that he interrupted a robbery at his dispensary and was attempting to follow the suspects who were fleeing from the facility. COTTON described the suspects as black males and stated one of them was wearing all blue. COTTON stated they were leaving the area in a green SUV with a California License Plate Number of 7VLR320. He lost sight of them as they got on the 94 westbound on ramp.

BACKGROUND:

There are multiple buildings located inside the premises of 6176 Federal Avenue, one of which is the dispensary itself. There is an RV and van, both of which are occupied by witnesses to the incident, within the gates of the premises. Jason WALKER (Witness) lives in the van that is parked on the premises.

INVESTIGATION:

I arrived on scene at approximately 1059 hours. When I arrived, I contacted Anna MARTINEZ (Witness) in the driveway of the complex as she was attempting to leave in her vehicle. MARTINEZ was frantic and insisted she needed to leave the premises. I told her she could not leave and asked her for information about what happened and who was inside of the office. MARTINEZ was uncooperative and told me she was going to park her car outside of the gate and then provide all the information I needed. MARTINEZ then drove her car off of the lot and left the area.

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Immediately after MARTINEZ fled the area, I contacted Jeffrey HAGLER in the driveway. HAGLER stated he had been robbed at gunpoint and related to me that there was a small possibility one of the armed suspects was still inside of the office. At that time, I took a position near the side entrance of the office and watched the door in case the suspect exited the building. I then waited for additional units to arrive. Once additional units arrived, I went inside the office and assisted in clearing the building. Once we confirmed there were no suspects inside of the building, I went back outside and obtained the following statements from Jeffrey HAGLER (Victim) and Jason WALKER (Witness).

Statement of Jeffrey HAGLER (Victim):

Today (06/10/17), at approximately 1049 hours, HAGLER was sitting at his workstation reading the news on his computer. HAGLER suddenly heard people come through the door which is located directly behind his workstation. When HAGLER turned around, he saw a black male wearing a mask point a gun in his face. The man told him to get down on the ground and HAGLER immediately complied. When HAGLER laid face down on the office floor, one of the men tied his hands behind his back with duct tape. They then taped his feet together at the ankles.

HAGLER then heard one of the men ask, "Where's your wallet?", "Where's the cash?". HAGLER told the men his wallet was behind his computer. One of the men grabbed his wallet, removed \$280 in cash from inside and then threw the wallet on the floor. One of the men then asked HAGLER for the office keys and removed them from the pocket of his pants. HAGLER then heard the men moving about the office and it sounded as though they were placing bags and jars of marijuana in bags. The men then exited the office.

Shortly after HAGLER heard the men leave the office, Jason WALKER came in and untied him. HAGLER could not provide a description of the males. He stated he only remembered seeing the barrel of the gun that was pointed in his face. HAGLER believed the gun was a revolver. HAGLER believed the suspects were black because he could see portions of their faces through the masks they were wearing. He was unable to provide any further description about the males.

Statement of Jason WALKER (Witness):

Today (06/10/17), at approximately 1049 hours, WALKER was inside one of the adjoining buildings at 6176 Federal Avenue. He was playing video poker on his tablet when he suddenly heard the dogs barking outside. Anna MARTINEZ came in and told him the dogs were loose in the backyard. WALKER then went outside to help MARTINEZ gather the dogs. When WALKER came outside, he saw Darryl COTTON (the owner of the dispensary) walking toward the gated entry. COTTON attempted to go inside of the office but found that the door to the office was locked which was

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unusual. COTTON then unlocked the door and attempted to open it. When COTTON attempted to open the door, someone pushed the door closed. COTTON then forced his way into the door and encountered a black male, wearing a yellow/reflective construction jacket and hard hat. The male was wearing a dust mask. The male (SUSPECT 1) then came at COTTON aggressively. COTTON and WALKER both ran away from the male in opposite directions.

WALKER lost sight of COTTON as COTTON ran toward Federal BLVD. WALKER then went up the stairs that lead to the roof of the office in an attempt to gain a vantage point of where the SUSPECTS were. WALKER then saw a second male (SUSPECT 2) exit the office and run toward Federal Blvd. When SUSPECT 2 ran toward the street, Anna MARTINEZ attempted to punch him as he ran by her. SUSPECT 2 dropped one of the bags he was holding and continued to run in a westerly direction until he was out of sight. WALKER did not see anyone else exit the office.

WALKER went inside the office and saw Jeffrey HAGLER tied up on the floor. He then cut HAGLER loose and helped him to his feet. Police arrived on scene shortly thereafter.

WALKER described SUSPECT 1 as a black male, approximately 5'7" tall with a thin build. He described SUSPECT 2 as an unknown race male, with a heavy build wearing blue jacket and blue jeans.

INVESTIGATION CONT'D:

While I was obtaining HAGLER and WALKER'S statement, a cashier at the nearby liquor store notified my partner, Officer B. Shields #7231, that someone was hiding behind his store. Officer Shields went to investigate and found Anna MARTINEZ (Witness) hiding behind a truck. Officer Shields detained MARTINEZ and obtained her statement. See ARJIS-9 by Officer Shields for details. Additionally Officer Shields obtained a statement from Darryl COTTON.

The Robbery Unit was notified and a Detective responded to the scene. I obtained elimination DNA swabs from Jason WALKER and secured them as evidence. Officer Shields took photos of the crime scene and secured them as evidence. Additionally, Officer Shields collected multiple items inside of the office as evidence. See Evidence section of Officer Shields report for details.

I gave COTTON and HAGLER each a Marsy's Card and Case Number as reference.

Narcotics Detective Sgt., Sgt. Stiasny was also informed about the incident.
