The Court has considered the briefing in support of, and in opposition to, defendant Donald Campbell's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint, as well as the briefing in support of, and in opposition to, the other defendants' motions to dismiss. The Court **GRANTS** Campbell's Motion to Dismiss and **ORDERS** Plaintiff's Complaint dismissed with prejudice. The Complaint does not allege a claim under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(6).

Plaintiff does not state a TVPA claim against Campbell, and because the alleged conduct did not involve "interstate commerce," the TVPA claim is dismissed with prejudice.

As for the remaining state law claims for sexual assault and battery, each is based on alleged conduct Plaintiff asserts took place in May 2013. California law required Plaintiff to bring her assault and battery claims by no later than May 2015. Plaintiff's state law claims for sexual assault and battery against Campbell are time barred and dismissed with prejudice.
