Request

This is a request under the California Public Records Act (Gov. Code § 7920.000 et seq.) to inspect and obtain copies of the records described below.

Clarification of scope. On June 16–17, 2026, the Industrial Wastewater Control Program advised me that this location is not permitted by IWCP because it does not discharge industrial wastewater to the sewer from the site. This request concerns a different program: the Trucked Domestic Waste Hauler Permit under which a company hauls and discharges septic-tank, portable-toilet, or other domestic (chemical-toilet) waste into the City sewer at a designated receiving station. The parties of interest are United Rentals (North America), Inc., operating as “Reliable Onsite Services” (Branch 70M), at 6144 Federal Blvd., and the vehicles operated from that yard.

Records requested:

1. Any current or past Trucked Domestic Waste Hauler Permit (or equivalent trucked-waste discharge permit or registration) issued to United Rentals (North America), Inc., “Reliable Onsite Services,” or to vehicles operated from 6144 Federal Blvd. — including the permit(s) and the permit application(s), with the list of trucks (make/model, year, tank capacity, license) submitted with them.
2. All discharge or offload records submitted or maintained under any such permit — including dates, volumes discharged, the receiving station or location, and any associated manifests, hauler logs, or trip records.
3. Any record reflecting that no such permit exists or has been issued to these parties.
4. Any inspection reports, correspondence, notices, or enforcement records concerning trucked-waste hauling or discharge by these parties, or concerning the 6144 Federal Blvd. operation's disposal of portable-toilet / septage waste.
5. Any records identifying where portable-toilet / septage waste collected by these parties is authorized to be, or is, discharged or disposed.

Date range: January 1, 2023 to the date this request is processed.

Please provide records electronically where possible. To minimize cost, please notify me before incurring any duplication or programming charges (Gov. Code §§ 7922.530, 7922.575) so I can confirm before fees are incurred. This request invokes the agency's duty to assist under § 7922.600(a); if any part is unclear or can be focused to speed production, please contact me. If any record or portion is withheld, please cite the specific exemption and produce all reasonably segregable non-exempt portions (Gov. Code §§ 7922.525, 7922.000). Please provide the determination required by § 7922.535(a) within 10 days.
