This Version 4.1 supersedes and replaces Daily Supplement No. 4, which I submitted on August 4, 2026. When I sent Supplement No. 4 I did not believe I had yet analyzed the City of El Cajon’s production to the extent this version does. On further consideration I am providing that fuller analysis in its place, as a single, self-contained, Bates-numbered package, so that this latest version — and the reasons for it — are defined and part of one record. It remains time-sensitive: the operation it concerns is ongoing, and the conditions it has produced continue to fall on me and on a group of some ninety neighbors and members of this community who have lived and worked alongside United Rentals’ handling of human waste at 6144 Federal Boulevard. I have been personally harmed by it, and I do not stand alone in that. Each matter below is stated at a high level and points to the exhibit or figure that sets it out.

Part 1. The video log. (Exhibit A)

A video log documenting the continuous use of United Rentals’ vacuum trucks in pumping operations at the FRAC tank — seven days a week and at all hours of the day and night, including before dawn — updated through the date of this submission. Each recording, with its date, time, and what it shows (one or more trucks in operation with the FRAC tank), is set out in Exhibit A. A single ordinary Tuesday, August 4, 2026, is illustrative: five separate captures between 12:27 p.m. and 4:27 p.m. show the operation running repeatedly across one day, on no announced or apparent “large event.” **(EX A, Video Log, Pg’s 0010-0012)**

Part 2. The operation’s history and the City of El Cajon production, year by year. (Exhibit B)

The historical satellite record of the yard establishes the operation’s timeline. The yard is empty in March and December 2020. By August 2021 it is full of staged units and vacuum trucks — the operation is running. Yet the City of El Cajon’s account records show United Rentals did not begin disposing at El Cajon until December 2022 — roughly eighteen months after the operation began. For that first year and a half the operation ran and its waste went somewhere else; the only lawful destinations on the permit are the City of San Diego’s Pump Station #1 and OCSD Fountain Valley. El Cajon disposal was therefore not a startup’s default choice, but a deliberate, mid-stream decision by an established operation to move its disposal to an out-of-jurisdiction station that appears on no version of its County permit.

For the first time, an agency has produced records showing where United Rentals’ septage actually went. The City of El Cajon’s own account records show some 5.5 million gallons of septage (5,445,200 gallons) disposed at El Cajon over 43 consecutive months, December 2022 through June 2026, billed at \$536,896.72 — at a facility that appears on no version of United Rentals’ County Sewage Hauler Permit, and that, under El Cajon’s own municipal code, may not lawfully accept waste generated outside the City without a City Council authorization no record reflects. United Rentals did not sign even an administrative El Cajon discharge permit until April 23, 2025 — roughly twenty-eight months after that billing began, by which date approximately three million gallons (about 56% of the total) had already been accepted. The El Cajon Council-authorization requirement for out-of-city waste (El Cajon Municipal Code § 13.20.130) has been in force since 2009 — the entire disposal period.

Those records — together with the anomalies they raise — are assembled in Exhibit B, tab by tab:

Read by year, the volume escalates — roughly 1.05 million gallons in 2023, 1.56 million in 2024 (a 49% jump, coinciding with the FRAC tank entering service that February), and 1.88 million in 2025. The specific determinations these records call for are set out, each tied to its exhibit page, in the Questions Presented for the Record that close Exhibit B. **(EX B, El Cajon Production Records, Pg’s 0014-0122)**

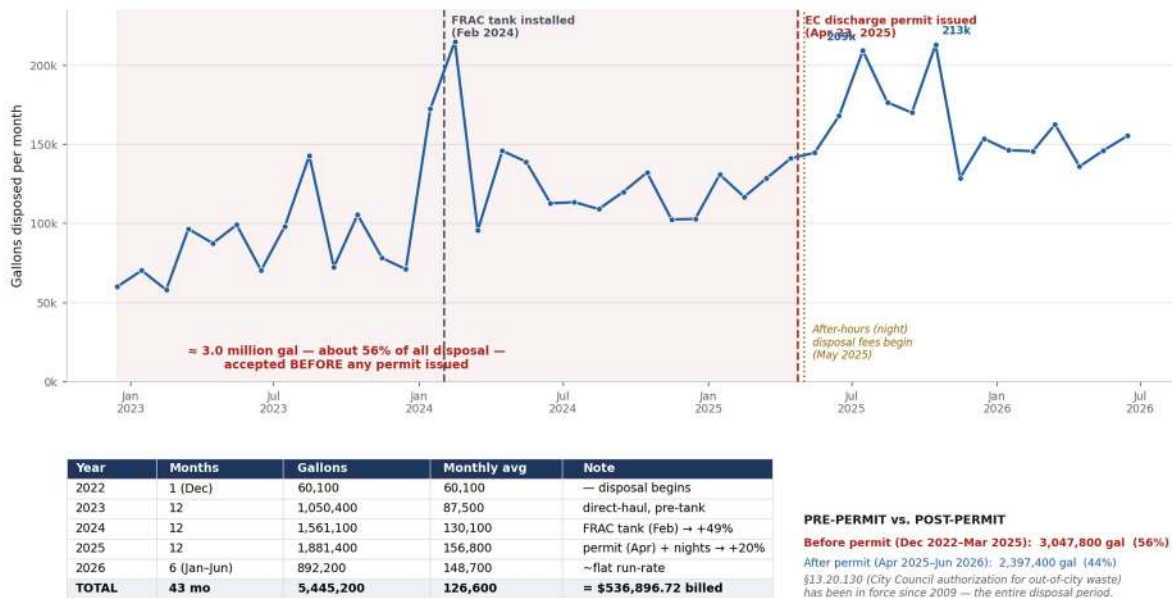


Figure 2. Monthly gallons disposed at El Cajon, Dec 2022 – Jun 2026, with the FRAC-tank and permit dates marked. ~56% of the total was accepted before any El Cajon permit issued.

Part 3. The destination makes no economic sense — and the “large events” representation. (Exhibit C)

On July 30, 2026 the City’s stormwater inspector, Daniel De Curtins, relayed to me United Rentals’ explanation that the FRAC tank is used “only for large events.” The El Cajon records in Exhibit B cannot be reconciled with that account: they show continuous, gallon-metered disposal in every one of those 43 consecutive months. My July 30 email memorializing the statement — copied to Leon Wirschem at the County DEHQ — with a short analysis of how it stands against the records, is set out in Exhibit C. **(EX C, De Curtins / Wirschem Email, Pg’s 0124-0125)**

The economics deepen the problem. United Rentals’ own sworn permit names the City of San Diego’s Pump Station #1 as the primary authorized destination — and that station was, in every respect, the sensible choice. It is cheaper: San Diego’s domestic-septage rate was \$74–\$88 per 1,000 gallons across these years, against El Cajon’s flat \$98.60. It is closer to the yard: roughly six miles, versus thirteen to fifteen miles to El Cajon. And it is authorized. Measured against San Diego’s rates, United Rentals paid on the order of \$93,000 more to dispose at El Cajon than the permitted San Diego station would have cost.

What United Rentals Paid El Cajon vs. What San Diego Would Have Charged — by Year

Domestic septage disposal. El Cajon: \$98.60 / 1,000 gal (actual, flat, all years).
San Diego rate reconstructed from the City's adopted sewer increases (+5/4/4/3/6%) applied to its confirmed 2026 rate of \$87.56.

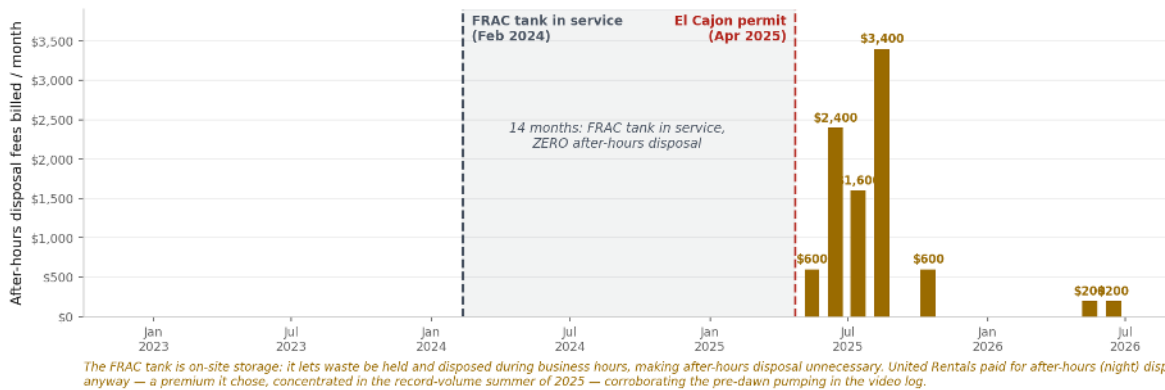
Applying San Diego's actual year-by-year rates, United Rentals paid about \$93,000 MORE to use El Cajon than the permitted San Diego station would have cost (a conservative floor, using only the confirmed 2026 rate for every year, is ~\$60,000). Either way: they paid a large premium for the pricier, out-of-jurisdiction station — one that, unlike San Diego's Pump Station #1 (Mon-Sat 5a-5p), offered after-hours access.

The after-hours record compounds it. Pump Station #1 is open Monday–Saturday, 5:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. El Cajon's records show United Rentals began paying after-hours (night) disposal fees only in May 2025 — none before, including the fourteen months the FRAC tank had already been in service. A FRAC tank is on-site storage; its function is to let waste be held and disposed during business hours, making after-hours disposal unnecessary. United Rentals paid for it anyway — between 45 and 90 after-hours discharges, concentrated in the record-volume summer of 2025 — corroborating the pre-dawn pumping documented in the video log. No legitimate rationale — cost, distance, permit authorization, or hours — favors El Cajon over Pump Station #1; every one favors the station the permit names. The absence of any legitimate justification for driving farther, to pay more, to dispose off its own sworn permit in another jurisdiction and at hours the permitted station is closed, is itself the fact that requires explanation.

United Rentals — After-Hours (Night) Disposal Fees at El Cajon

El Cajon month-end records (\$100 scheduled / \$200 emergency per after-hours visit). Zero for 29 months — including 14 months the FRAC tank was already in service — then

Part 4. The threshold question — is the 6144 Federal Boulevard FRAC-tank operation a one-off? (Exhibit D)

There is a question that, on reflection, sits beneath everything else in this record. A portable-sanitation company pumps and hauls: the waste moves through the truck to a permitted facility and is not held. At 6144 Federal Boulevard, United Rentals does something different — it holds commingled human waste in a fixed,

above-ground bulk FRAC tank before disposal. The question is why, and whether it does this anywhere else in its system.

The science, briefly. Human waste is biologically active, and the moment it is held without oxygen — as it is inside a sealed bulk tank — it begins to break down anaerobically, a process known as septicity, or the waste “going septic.” Anaerobic decomposition generates hydrogen sulfide and methane and drives the material’s pH downward. Two variables govern how far it goes: temperature and time. The warmer the waste and the longer it is held, the further the reaction proceeds — the activity of the sulfide-generating bacteria roughly doubles with every eighteen-degree-Fahrenheit rise in temperature. A fixed steel tank standing in open sun, holding commingled waste over days, is close to an ideal vessel for driving that reaction to its extreme.

The product of that reaction is exactly what the disposal-standards regime exists to keep out of a public system: hydrogen sulfide is toxic; hydrogen sulfide and methane are both flammable and can build toward an explosive concentration in a tank’s enclosed head-space; and the depressed pH leaves the material corrosive and off-specification for lawful discharge. EPA’s own guidance recognizes the anaerobic, sulfide-generating, corrosive character of stored septage and directs that enclosed storage tanks be monitored for hydrogen sulfide, oxygen, and the lower explosive limit. (EPA, Guide to Septage Treatment and Disposal, EPA/625/R-94/002.) The federal pretreatment standards, in turn, prohibit introducing into a public system any pollutant that creates a fire or explosion hazard, or that causes corrosive structural damage, with discharges below pH 5.0 barred outright. (40 C.F.R. § 403.5(b).)

Holding septage in a fixed bulk tank is therefore not how this business is ordinarily conducted. United Rentals is a national operator, and it knows this science. It knows that septage held in bulk goes septic, and it knows that the rate at which that occurs — a function of temperature and time — can drive the material to levels of acidity, hydrogen sulfide, and flammable gas that make its discharge unlawful. Those levels are not a matter of opinion; they are defined in the federal pretreatment standards, 40 C.F.R. § 403.5, and in the receiving facility’s own sewer-use and pretreatment ordinance. A company that handles this material for a living operates against that knowledge.

That knowledge is what prompted me to determine whether United Rentals employs this bulk-storage method at any of its other Reliable Onsite Services operations. Using publicly available aerial imagery, I surveyed United Rentals / Reliable Onsite Services yards across California, county by county, reviewing each for the fixed, unmistakable signature of a bulk-storage tank. The results are set out in the California Yard Survey. Across every yard surveyed, only one holds septage in a fixed bulk tank — 6144 Federal Boulevard. Every other yard, including United Rentals’ own active Reliable Onsite yard at 2231 La Mirada Drive in Vista, runs the ordinary pump-and-haul way, with no fixed tank. On this record, 6144 Federal Boulevard stands alone. **(EX D, California Yard Survey, Pg’s 0127-0136)**

Because only United Rentals knows the full extent of its national operations, it remains United Rentals — not I — that is positioned to confirm whether bulk on-site storage of septage occurs anywhere else in its system. But on the California record I have developed, the practice is confined to this single location, adjacent to my property and my neighbors’. If it exists nowhere else, the 6144 Federal Boulevard tank is a one-off, and that itself tells the agencies something about the choice made here; if it exists elsewhere, it is a matter the agencies will want to pursue.

There is a further inference the agencies may fairly draw. If on-site bulk storage of septage made financial sense and produced material that could be lawfully discharged, a national operator would have every reason to standardize the practice across its yards and capture that benefit everywhere it operates. United Rentals has not — its yards across California run without it. A company does not ordinarily decline to replicate a practice that is genuinely both cheaper and lawful; that this one is confined to 6144 Federal Boulevard suggests the advantage it offers lies in something other than ordinary, lawful operation — in disposing of material, at a station that does not test it, that a monitored facility might not accept.

United Rentals appears to have understood where the exposure lay. On July 8, 2026 — the same day County inspectors were at the yard — its branch manager emailed the El Cajon station to ask, “By chance does your team do PH testing?” That a hauler would ask whether the receiving station tests pH, rather than take it for granted, is telling: it indicates the material’s characterization was neither routinely verified at El Cajon nor assumed by the hauler to be. What prompted the question, and whether the City ever tested this account’s discharges at all, are among the matters now before the City in the supplement to PRR26-679. **(EX B, EX-6 El Cajon Correspondence, Pg 0109)**

Part 5. The public and environmental stakes.

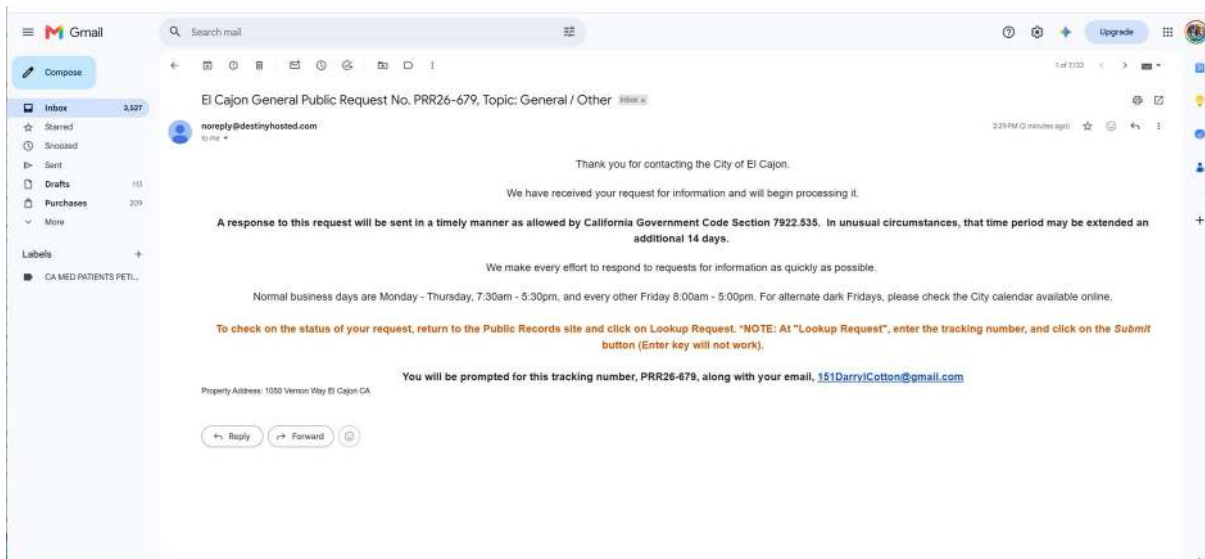
These are not private grievances or paperwork gaps; they reach the public interest on two fronts.

Public funds and system integrity. The City of San Diego’s ratepayer-funded wastewater system — the very destination United Rentals’ permit names — collected nothing on 5.4 million gallons of waste generated within San Diego, because that waste was diverted to another city. El Cajon, in turn, accepted out-of-jurisdiction waste that, under its own code, may not lawfully be accepted without a City Council authorization no record reflects. And United Rentals paid a premium to route the waste through a flat-rate account rather than San Diego’s permitted station, whose self-monitoring and manifest requirements exist precisely to protect the public system — avoiding that oversight is the apparent object of the premium. A permit that names two destinations while the operation disposes at a third, off-permit, for years, hollows out the permitting regime the public relies on.

Public health and the environment. The unpermitted FRAC-tank operation this permit was meant to govern is the same fixed, above-ground unpermitted FRAC-tank operation that sits in our residential-adjacent community, storing and transferring raw human waste. The emissions, odor, corrosion, and hazard concerns the unpermitted FRAC-tank operation raises are documented in the FRAC Tank Operations Report and its exhibits, have been the subject of confirmation by City and air-district inspectors, and are the reason some ninety neighbors have signed in objection. Raw human waste is among the most heavily regulated materials there is precisely because its mishandling carries direct consequences for public health and for the environment. An unpermitted FRAC-tank operation that handles millions of gallons of it off-permit, out of jurisdiction, at unmonitored hours, and through a system whose safeguards were bypassed, is not a bookkeeping problem — it is the public-health and environmental core of why this industry is licensed at all. The chemistry of that operation — why bulk storage of septage drives the material to toxic, explosive, and off-specification conditions — is set out in the threshold question at Part 4; the specific emission, odor, and receiving-water concerns are set out in the prior reports and exhibits already before the agencies.

Part 6. The expanded records search. (PRR 26-679)

Certain questions these records raise can only be answered by El Cajon’s own further production — in particular, the true source of the waste (whether it in fact all originates at 6144 Federal Blvd., as United Rentals claims), any authority for the disposal predating the April 2025 permit, the § 13.20.130 Council authorization, and the truck-by-truck Septic Station Sign-In Sheets that alone can reconcile the monthly volumes and identify each disposal. I have accordingly filed a further California Public Records Act request with the City of El Cajon, PRR26-679, acknowledged August 4, 2026 under Government Code § 7922.535. I include the acknowledgment so the record reflects that this search is under way.

Questions Raised Across all 4 Exhibits. (set out in full following Exhibit D)

Read together, the four exhibits pose a single question that only their combination can answer: in light of the video log showing United Rentals working the FRAC tank at all hours, seven days a week (Exhibit A); the City of El Cajon’s records showing continuous, gallon-metered disposal in every one of 43 consecutive months (Exhibit B); United Rentals’ representation to the City of San Diego’s stormwater inspector that the tank was used “only for large events” (Exhibit C); and the statewide survey showing that this fixed bulk-storage tank exists at 6144 Federal Boulevard and at no other United Rentals yard in California (Exhibit D) — can that representation, and this one-of-a-kind operation, be reconciled with the record these four exhibits make together? That is what this supplement asks the agencies to resolve. **(at Pg 0137)**

Taken together.

These matters describe discharges that fall outside what United Rentals was permitted to do — in where the waste went, in the on-site tank storage the permit does not authorize, and in a period that began well before any El Cajon authorization existed — together with a commercial arrangement to bring waste generated outside the City of El Cajon into the City’s system that, under the City’s own code, could not lawfully have been established without a City Council authorization no record reflects. They also describe an established, high-volume, all-hours operation that paid a substantial premium to dispose off its own sworn permit, in another jurisdiction, at hours the permitted San Diego station is closed, and with an on-site storage tank that made none of it necessary. These are not isolated paperwork gaps. They go to how United Rentals has chosen to operate an enterprise that is among the most heavily regulated there is, precisely because the material it handles — raw human waste — carries direct and serious consequences for public health and for the environment. The issues raised here therefore warrant being addressed not only as discrete items, but in the larger context of United Rentals’ operational and business practices: whether this is an enterprise conducted in full compliance with the obligations that stewardship demands, or one deliberately conducted around them. I ask that the compliance determination be reopened and revisited in that light.

And I ask for more than review. The County Sewage Hauler Permit under which this operation runs — LSHOP-000063 — authorizes the cleaning of portable restrooms and disposal at Pump Station #1 and OCSF Fountain Valley; it does not authorize the on-site FRAC-tank storage and transfer of septage at all. On that record, and given that United Rentals conducts every other California operation without such a tank (Exhibit D), I respectfully ask that the County — or any other agency with jurisdiction and authority to do so — give United Rentals / Reliable Onsite Services notice that it must immediately cease and desist the FRAC-tank

storage and transfer of septage at 6144 Federal Boulevard, and that continued operation, should the company decline to comply with that notice, will be grounds for enforcement up to and including revocation of its permit. The company operates every other yard in California without this tank; it can, and should, operate this one the same way.

Recorded evidence of the continuous, all-hours operation of the United Rentals FRAC tank at 6144 Federal Blvd., San Diego

This exhibit is a log of the recorded video and photographic evidence I have kept of the United Rentals operation at 6144 Federal Boulevard. Taken together, it documents an operation that runs at all hours — routinely before dawn, through the day, and into the night, seven days a week. Vacuum trucks and a single-compartment bulk hauler pump into and out of the fixed FRAC tank on no schedule a normal business would keep; the heaviest movements are captured in the pre-dawn dark, between roughly 2:00 and 5:00 a.m.

What the footage cannot fully convey is what it is like to work beside it. Day and night, the operation subjects my property at 6176 Federal Boulevard — and the businesses around it — to a horrific stench: the unmistakable odor of raw human waste and the gases it releases (hydrogen sulfide, ammonia, and methane), which are at once nauseating, toxic, and — around a FRAC tank of this kind — explosive. Over that runs the constant noise of diesel vacuum pumps and tankers. These are the working conditions the operation imposes on 6176, a commercial property carrying on its own lawful operations in that same fouled air. The point is not that a business operates nearby, or at what hour, but that this particular operation floods the shared air with toxic, foul gases and runs heavy equipment at all hours in a way no ordinary commercial use does. These conditions — the odor, the gases, and the noise — are what a group of some ninety neighbors and I have documented and reported for more than a year. The recordings below are identified by date and time; the underlying files are retained and available for inspection.



August 3, 2026 at 3:27 p.m. shows two United Rentals / Reliable Onsite vacuum tank trucks in operation with the unpermitted FRAC tank at their 6144 Federal Blvd. yard just 4 ft from my 6176 Federal Blvd. yard.

The County Sewage Hauler Permit LSHOP-000063 authorizes one service — cleaning portable restrooms — and disposal at two named facilities (Pump Station #1 and OCSD Fountain Valley); Jeffrey Walker signed it under penalty of perjury on September 18, 2024. Its 2025 Truck Inventory lists nine vehicles: eight double-tank vacuum trucks (695- or 1,100-gallon waste sides) and one 4,000-gallon Peterbilt bulk unit with no freshwater/cleaning tank. The Fleet Septage-Capacity Log totals only the eight double-tank vacuum trucks — 7,180 gallons, the most that service fleet can carry in a single round, and the yardstick against which El Cajon's daily volumes are read. The 4,000-gallon Peterbilt is deliberately left out of that figure: a single-compartment barrel with no freshwater side is a bulk transfer hauler, not a restroom-service truck, and the septage it moves has already been pumped by the vacuum trucks and staged in the FRAC tank — so counting it as collection capacity would double-count the same gallons on their second leg to disposal. The permit does not authorize a fixed on-site FRAC tank or the on-site storage/transfer of septage, and does not name El Cajon.

Signed by the same Jeffrey Walker on April 23, 2025, these are the City of El Cajon Septic/Sewage Discharge Permit application (6144 Federal) and the issued permit (sister Vista branch) — the instruments authorizing disposal at El Cajon, a facility the County permit (Exhibit 2) does not name. The application lists 12 vehicles; comparing them to the DEHQ Truck Inventory (Exhibit 2) surfaces three anomalies. First, 7 of the DEHQ-permitted trucks also appear here — the same documented fleet is on both permits. Second, 2 trucks are on the DEHQ permit but NOT on this El Cajon roster (tags 3710606, 3778078) — so they can move septage into the on-site FRAC tank without ever appearing in El Cajon's records; El Cajon is none the wiser. Third, 5 trucks appear here but carry NO DEHQ decal (tags 01851Y2, 3145317, 3213370, 3224527, 3224519) — the County has no registration for them, consistent with DEHQ being unaware they haul and discharge septage. By capacity too, the El Cajon roster is the larger: its 12 vehicles total 14,480 gallons of septage capacity (10,480 across the 11 double-tank vacuum trucks) against the DEHQ service fleet's 7,180-gallon ceiling (Exhibit 2). The single 4,000-gallon Peterbilt is set aside from the double-tank figures (7,180 and 10,480) for the reason given in Exhibit 2 — it is a bulk transfer hauler, not a collection vehicle, and its load is waste already staged in the FRAC tank — and is added only in the all-vehicles total (14,480). (UR services multiple sites; the fleet brings collected septage from various locations to El Cajon.)

SECTION SUMMARY

The City's daily disposal logs. The 2024 reports state a 'Sum of Capacity' (the summed rated capacity of each truck that signed in); the 2025-2026 reports state 'Total Gallons Dumped' (actual metered volume). Read against the fleet ceilings: 285 of 514 logged days exceed the DEHQ 7,180-gallon service-fleet ceiling (Exhibit 2); 79 exceed even the 11 EC-listed double-tank vacuum trucks (10,480 gallons, Exhibit 3); and 17 exceed all 12 EC-listed vehicles combined (14,480 gallons) — days that physically required refills or multiple trips no matter how the fleet is counted, leaving the 4,000-gallon bulk transfer from the FRAC tank as an open question. In the four 'Sum of Capacity' months (77 days), 35 days required a 695- or 1,100-gallon vacuum truck. The record also shows extreme swings (e.g., April 11, 2025 = 699 gallons; April 14 = 13,499). Smaller daily totals are consistent with a vacuum truck dumping directly in or near El Cajon. These are offered as anomalies, not conclusions.

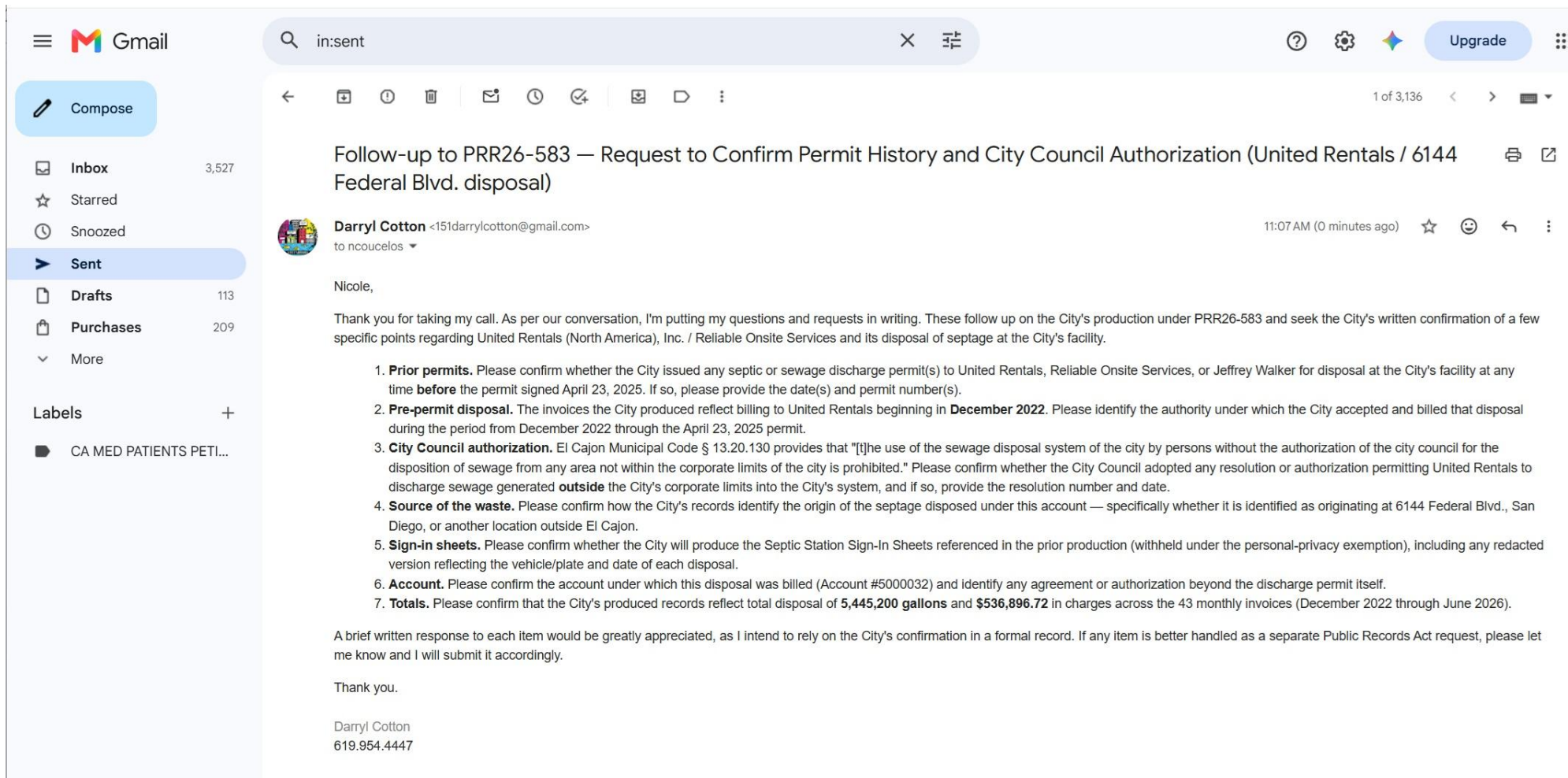
Cotton to City of El Cajon — Written Follow-Up Request re Permit History, Pre-Permit Authority, and City Council Authorization (August 4, 2026)

Questions put directly to the City; the City's response is awaited

SECTION SUMMARY

On August 4, 2026, following a telephone call with the City of El Cajon's records contact (N. Coucelos), I put my questions to the City in writing and requested the City's written confirmation on seven specific points. The email asks the City to confirm: (1) whether any septic or sewage discharge permit issued to United Rentals, Reliable Onsite Services, or Jeffrey Walker before the permit signed April 23, 2025 (Exhibit 3); (2) the authority under which the City accepted and billed the disposal from December 2022 through the April 23, 2025 permit — a period of roughly 28 months of billing that predates the permit (Exhibits 4, 8); (3) whether the City Council adopted any resolution authorizing United Rentals to discharge sewage generated OUTSIDE the City's corporate limits into the City's system, as El Cajon Municipal Code section 13.20.130 requires; (4) how the City's records identify the origin of the septage; (5) whether the City will produce the Septic Station Sign-In Sheets withheld under the personal-privacy exemption (Exhibit 1); (6) the billing account (Account #5000032, Exhibit 6); and (7) the produced totals of 5,445,200 gallons and \$536,896.72 (Exhibits 4, 7). As of this filing, the City's response is awaited. The seven questions correspond to the determinations set out in the accompanying Questions Presented for the Record.

THE EL CAJON PRODUCTION RESPONSE

What it proves, and the questions it raises for the regulating agencies

1. This matter is time-sensitive. The operation it concerns is ongoing, and the conditions it has produced continue to fall on me and on a group of some ninety neighbors and members of this community who have lived alongside United Rentals' handling of human waste at 6144 Federal Boulevard. I have been personally harmed by it, and I do not stand alone in that. For more than a year, the single question at the center of this — whether the septage United Rentals generates has been lawfully disposed of — has met nothing but resistance. The City of El Cajon is the first agency to address that question in a meaningful way, by producing the records that show where United Rentals' septage has actually gone. (*See LWQD Information Package dated July 31, 2026, Exhibit No. 9.*)
2. Those records, produced on August 3, 2026, make certain things clear, and in doing so they create the need for further determinations. What follows is not offered as a comprehensive account. It is offered because these are the issues that raise questions for me, and my belief is that they will raise the same questions for the agencies charged with regulating this operation — the agencies positioned to determine the answers. Accordingly, the El Cajon Production Response proves the following:
3. United Rentals disposed of septage at a City of El Cajon facility — 1050 Vernon Way — that appears on no version of its County Sewage Hauler Permit (LSHOP-000063), and did so as a paying commercial account (No. 5000032). **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-4, Pg's 0029-0072; EX-6, Pg 0102; EX-2, Pg's 0020-0022]** (*See LWQD Information Package dated July 31, 2026, Exhibit Nos. 7 and 9.*)
4. That disposal was not occasional but continuous and sustained — 43 consecutive months, December 2022 through June 2026, totaling 5,445,200 gallons billed by the gallon at \$536,896.72. **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-4, Pg's 0029-0072; EX-7, Pg 0111]** (*First established by the El Cajon production; no prior Supplement.*)
5. The disposal began in December 2022, roughly twenty-eight months before United Rentals obtained any El Cajon discharge permit, which its representative did not sign until April 23, 2025. **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-4, Pg 0030; EX-3, Pg 0025]** (*The 2022 origin: See LWQD Information Package dated July 31, 2026, Exhibit No. 8.*)
6. The same representative, Jeffrey Walker, signed both instruments: the County permit under penalty of perjury on September 18, 2024, naming only Pump Station #1 and OCSD Fountain Valley, and the El Cajon discharge application naming the very destination the County permit does not. **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-2, Pg's 0020-0022; EX-3, Pg 0025]** (*See LWQD Information Package dated July 31, 2026, Exhibit No. 3, at Bates 029.*)
7. The fleet serving the operation was only partly disclosed to the County — seven vehicles appear on both permits, five El Cajon-listed vehicles carry no County decal, and two County-permitted trucks appear nowhere on the El Cajon roster. **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-2, Pg 0023; EX-3, Pg 0028]** (*Permit truck inventory: See LWQD Information Package dated July 31, 2026, Exhibit No. 3; the cross-reference is new.*)
8. The El Cajon site operated as an around-the-clock, self-service station — drivers signed in by license plate, and the City billed a printed after-hours fee schedule (\$100 scheduled, \$200 emergency) — while withholding the individual sign-in sheets that would show the disposal truck-by-truck. **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-4, Pg's 0029-0072; EX-6, Pg 0105; EX-1, Pg's 0014-0018]** (*All-*

hours operation: See LWQD Information Package dated July 31, 2026, Exhibit No. 10 and Exhibit Nos. 5–6.)

9. No record exists, that I have been able to find — not in the City's records production, its published municipal code, or its City Council agendas and minutes — that El Cajon Municipal Code § 13.20.130 was ever satisfied. Because United Rentals' waste was generated at 6144 Federal Blvd., within the City of San Diego and outside El Cajon's corporate limits, City Council authorization under § 13.20.130 was the precondition to El Cajon lawfully granting a discharge permit for, or accepting, that waste at all. On the record produced, that authorization is absent for what can only be seen as the entire disposal period, from December 2022 through June 2026, and it remained absent even after United Rentals obtained its administrative El Cajon discharge permit on April 23, 2025. **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-3, Pg 0025; EX-4, Pg's 0029-0072; EX-7, Pg 0111; and ECMC § 13.20.130]**
10. On many days the volume discharged at El Cajon exceeded what United Rentals' permitted service fleet could carry in a single round — an anomaly the records document and that calls for explanation. **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-5, Pg's 0073-0100; EX-2, Pg 0023]** *(First established by the El Cajon daily logs; no prior Supplement.)*
11. The continuous, 43-month billing record stands in direct contradiction to United Rentals' representation to the City's stormwater inspector that the FRAC tank was used “only for large events.” **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-4, Pg's 0029-0072; EX-7, Pg 0111]** *(The representation: See LWQD Information Package dated July 31, 2026, Exhibit No. 1.)*
12. Taken together, these records describe discharges that fall outside what United Rentals was permitted to do — in where the waste went, in the on-site tank storage and transfer that the permit does not authorize, and in the period of disposal that began well before any El Cajon authorization existed. They describe, further, a commercial arrangement to bring waste generated outside the City of El Cajon into the City's disposal system — an arrangement that, under the City's own code, could not lawfully have been established without a City Council authorization that no record reflects. These are not isolated paperwork gaps. They go to how United Rentals has chosen to operate an enterprise that is among the most heavily regulated there is, precisely because the material it handles — raw human waste — carries direct and serious consequences for public health and for the environment. Those consequences are the reason public health and environmental stewardship sit at the very foundations on which this industry is permitted to operate at all, and an operation built on that footing depends on its operators meeting the permitting, disposal, and disclosure obligations that make the whole system accountable. The issues raised here therefore warrant being addressed not only as discrete items, but in the larger context of United Rentals' operational and business practices: whether this is an enterprise conducted in full compliance with the obligations that stewardship demands, or one deliberately conducted around them.
13. United Rentals may take the position that, because it held both a County Sewage Hauler Permit (LSHOP-000063) and a City of El Cajon discharge permit, it had a lawful choice of disposal destinations and was therefore in compliance. Whether that is so is not for me to decide; it is for the agencies to determine — principally the County DEHQ — Land and Water Quality Division, and, as to the receiving facility, the City of El Cajon. The facts above create the need for the further determinations set out below. I pose them as questions, in the form “in light of [the record fact], [the question]” — each tied to the exhibit and page that raises it — and ask that the agencies' response address them. The exhibits are those assembled in the El Cajon Off-Permit Disposal volume (EX-1 through EX-10).

QUESTIONS PRESENTED FOR THE RECORD

A. The scope of the permit.

1. In light of the fact that permit LSHOP-000063 names only two disposal facilities — Pump Station #1 and OCSD Fountain Valley **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-2, Pg's 0020-0022]**, does the permit limit lawful disposal to those two facilities, or may the permittee discharge at any other facility authorized to receive septage?
2. In light of the fact that the City of El Cajon's invoices and month-end totals show routine, gallon-metered disposal at El Cajon — a facility the permit does not name **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-4, Pg's 0029-0072; EX-7, Pg 0111]**, does that disposal conform to permit LSHOP-000063?

B. The sequence of authorization.

3. In light of the fact that the City of El Cajon billed United Rentals for gallon-metered disposal beginning in December 2022 **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-4, Pg 0030]**, while United Rentals' El Cajon discharge-permit application was not signed until April 23, 2025 **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-3, Pg 0025]**, under what authorization did the roughly twenty-eight months of El Cajon disposal that preceded that application occur?
4. In light of the fact that the City's invoices show disposal in the years before any El Cajon permit existed **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-4, Pg's 0030-0072]**, does the discharge permit obtained in April 2025 **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-3, Pg 0025]** bear on, or authorize, that earlier disposal?

C. The accuracy of the sworn permit.

5. In light of the fact that permit LSHOP-000063 was signed under penalty of perjury on September 18, 2024 and names only Pump Station #1 and OCSD **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-2, Pg's 0020-0022]**, and that by that date the City of El Cajon had already billed United Rentals for roughly twenty-one consecutive months of disposal **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-4, Pg's 0029-0072]**, did the permit, as signed, accurately state the operation's actual disposal destination?
6. In light of the fact that County permit LSHOP-000063 continues to name only Pump Station #1 and OCSD **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-2, Pg's 0020-0022]**, does the separate El Cajon permit **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-3, Pg's 0024-0028]** amend or otherwise alter the destinations authorized under the County permit?

D. The fixed tank — independent of any destination.

7. In light of the fact that permit LSHOP-000063 authorizes the cleaning of portable restrooms and disposal at a permitted facility **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-2, Pg's 0019-0022]**, does it authorize the on-site storage or transfer of septage in a fixed, above-ground FRAC tank at 6144 Federal Blvd.?
8. In light of the fact that no permit produced to date authorizes the FRAC tank at 6144 Federal Blvd. **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-2, Pg's 0019-0022]**, was the tank itself ever installed and operated under any permit, independent of where the septage is ultimately discharged? (City of San Diego building, mechanical, and fire-permit records are the subject of a separate, pending request.)

E. The receiving facility — and whether El Cajon could accept out-of-city waste at all.

United Rentals' yard at 6144 Federal Blvd. lies within the City of San Diego, outside the corporate limits of the City of El Cajon. El Cajon Municipal Code § 13.20.130 (“Service to areas outside city — Unauthorized use”) provides that “[t]he use of the sewage disposal system of the city by persons without the authorization of the city council for the disposition of sewage from any area not within the corporate limits of the city is prohibited.” Against that provision:

9. In light of the fact that the records identify the El Cajon disposal site as 1050 Vernon Way **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-3, Pg's 0024-0028; EX-6, Pg 0102]**, is that site a facility authorized to receive out-of-jurisdiction, private-hauler septage at all?
10. In light of the fact that 6144 Federal Blvd. lies within the City of San Diego — outside El Cajon's corporate limits — and that El Cajon Municipal Code § 13.20.130 bars use of the City's sewage disposal system for the disposition of sewage from outside the city “without the authorization of the city council,” was there any City Council authorization for United Rentals to dispose of this out-of-city sewage at the El Cajon facility?
11. In light of the fact that the City of El Cajon accepted and billed United Rentals for this disposal for 43 consecutive months, from December 2022 **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-4, Pg 0030]** through June 2026 **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-4, Pg 0072]**, how did out-of-city disposal come to be accepted and continue for years — does the City's own record reflect a Council authorization under § 13.20.130, or an arrangement maintained without one?

F. The fleet.

12. In light of the fact that five vehicles on United Rentals' El Cajon roster carry no DEHQ decal **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-3, Pg 0028]**, are those vehicles registered sewage haulers with the County; and if not, under what authority did they haul and discharge septage?
13. In light of the fact that two vehicles on the DEHQ permit (tags 3710606 and 3778078) do not appear on the El Cajon roster — and so could move septage into the on-site tank without appearing in El Cajon's records **[EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-2, Pg 0023; EX-3, Pg 0028]**, is their disposal accounted for anywhere in the County's records?

These are posed as questions, not conclusions. Each rests on a fact drawn from the agencies' own records, and each is one the agencies are positioned to resolve. I ask only that the answers — or the absence of them — be made part of the record in PRA 26-3709.

SECTION SUMMARY

This is my July 30, 2026 email (subject “United Rentals 6144 Federal Blvd.”) to City of San Diego stormwater inspector Daniel DeCurtins, copying Leon Wirschem of the County DEHQ. It memorializes, the same day it was said, United Rentals’ explanation as the inspector relayed it to me: that the FRAC tank is used “only for large events,” for the times the company cannot take its septage to Pump Station #1.

WHAT THAT STATEMENT MEANS, AGAINST THE EL CAJON RECORDS (EXHIBIT B)

United Rentals’ account casts the tank as an occasional buffer — a rare, large-event overflow. The El Cajon records in Exhibit B cannot be reconciled with it. They show not occasional use but continuous, gallon-metered disposal at El Cajon — 43 consecutive months, December 2022 through June 2026, roughly 5.45 million gallons billed at \$536,896.72 — and not at Pump Station #1, but at a facility named on no version of United Rentals’ County permit. A tank described to a City inspector as a rare overflow is, on the receiving city’s own books, the hub of a routine, year-round disposal operation. Against Exhibit B, the “large events” explanation does not hold.

Hi Daniel,

Thank you for the call earlier. I'm happy to learn that after your investigation into the Chollas Creek Channel drain which is in the United Rentals yard, you have confirmed that there is no evidence that would suggest there is a connection from the bulk storage Frac tank that would discharge into the channel. I'm actually very relieved to hear that. However when they told you that tank is only used for "large events" where there is so much septage they can't take it to the SD Pump Station 1 at 3550 East Harbor Drive which is where they are supposed to be discharging all their septage. That is not only not the case but there is nothing in their waste hauler permit (see attached) that would allow them to do that. This may be a problem for Leon at DEHQ whose agency inspects their onsite operations, and would have had to authorize the compliance and use of that tank for any bulk storage not listed on their permit.

Is the 6144 Federal Blvd. FRAC Tank a One-Off Operation From All Their Other California Sites?

A survey of United Rentals / Reliable Onsite Services yards across California: the fixed bulk-storage septage (“FRAC”) tank appears at 6144 Federal Boulevard and at no other yard surveyed.

The concern.

My concern, and my neighbors’, is a straightforward one of public health and safety. The operation at 6144 Federal Boulevard holds raw human waste (septage) in a fixed, above-ground bulk storage tank before disposal. Human waste held that way does not sit inert — it goes septic, generating hydrogen sulfide (toxic), methane (flammable, capable of building to an explosive concentration in an enclosed tank), and acids that drive the material corrosive and off-specification for lawful discharge. These are the very conditions the septage-disposal standards exist to prevent — the federal pretreatment standards bar introducing into a public system any pollutant that creates a fire or explosion hazard or corrosive damage, with discharges below pH 5.0 barred outright (40 C.F.R. § 403.5(b)), and U.S. EPA guidance directs that enclosed septage storage tanks be monitored for hydrogen sulfide, oxygen, and the lower explosive limit (EPA, Guide to Septage Treatment and Disposal, EPA/625/R-94/002). A fixed tank standing in open sun, holding commingled waste over days, is close to an ideal vessel for driving that reaction to its extreme — in a residential-adjacent community, beside the § 303(d)-impaired Chollas Creek.

Temperature and time are what make the manner of storage matter. **There is a reason septic tanks are installed underground.** Septage kept cool and moving breaks down slowly; septage held warm and still sours fast — the sulfide-generating activity roughly doubles with every eighteen-degree-Fahrenheit rise in temperature. A sealed steel tank standing above ground in open sun holds this material warm and still: the contents heat, the septic reaction is driven hardest, and the toxic and flammable gases it generates collect at grade, beside people. Whatever the rules may allow as to how such a tank is sited, the physics do not change — an above-ground steel tank in the sun is close to the worst way to hold septage.

This exhibit does not ask anyone to take my word for how unusual that is. It shows it. United Rentals is a national operator that runs this same portable-sanitation business — under the Reliable Onsite Services name — at yards across California. If holding septage in a fixed bulk tank were a normal, safe, and accepted way to conduct this business, one would expect to find it at those yards too. It is not there. I surveyed them, and 6144 Federal Boulevard stands alone.

Why the tank, and not the trucks, is the issue.

Portable sanitation is a pump-and-haul business. Vacuum trucks pump the portable units and transport the waste directly to a permitted disposal facility; the septage never has to be held on site. Holding it in bulk is not a service the business requires — it only adds cost (the tank, the yard space, and a second handling step) and it adds the septicity hazard described above. That is why a fixed bulk-storage tank is the telling feature: mobile trucks come and go and a single overhead image can miss them, but a fixed tank is a permanent structure that shows plainly in aerial imagery. Its presence or absence at a yard is therefore something that can be established from the public record — and it is what this survey establishes.

Method.

Using publicly available aerial imagery (Google Earth), I reviewed United Rentals / Reliable Onsite Services yards identified across California, county by county, looking at each for the signature of a fixed bulk-storage tank: a large horizontal cylindrical vessel with rounded ends and a top access hatch. Where a yard sits in a

multi-tenant complex, I attributed equipment to its actual operator (for example, the concrete-plant silos beside the Gilroy yard are a neighbor's, not United Rentals'). The result is set out below. This survey is ongoing toward all 58 California counties; the yards reviewed to date are listed here, and additional counties have been captured at the locator level pending yard-level review.

Finding.

Across every United Rentals / Reliable Onsite Services yard surveyed in California, only one — 6144 Federal Boulevard — has a fixed bulk-storage septage tank. Every other yard runs the business the ordinary way: service fleet, portable units, and equipment, with no fixed tank.

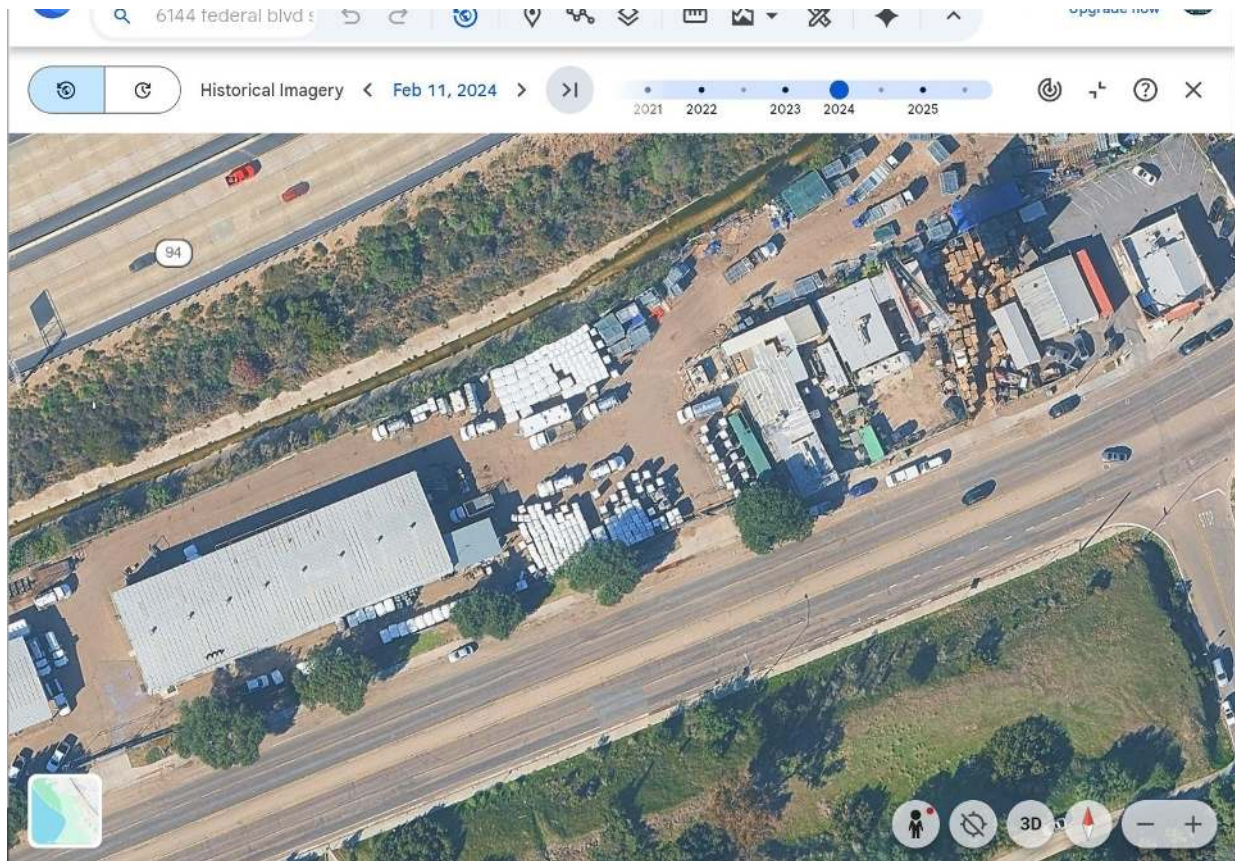

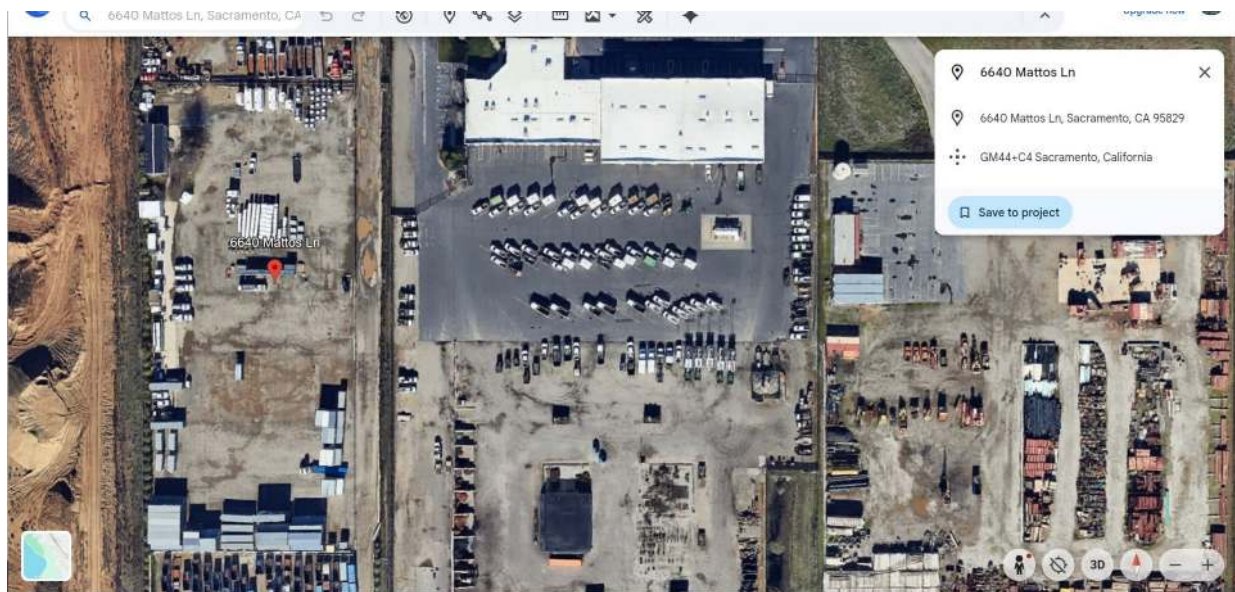
7910 Othello Ave., San Diego (San Diego County) — active branch and service fleet. No fixed bulk-storage tank.



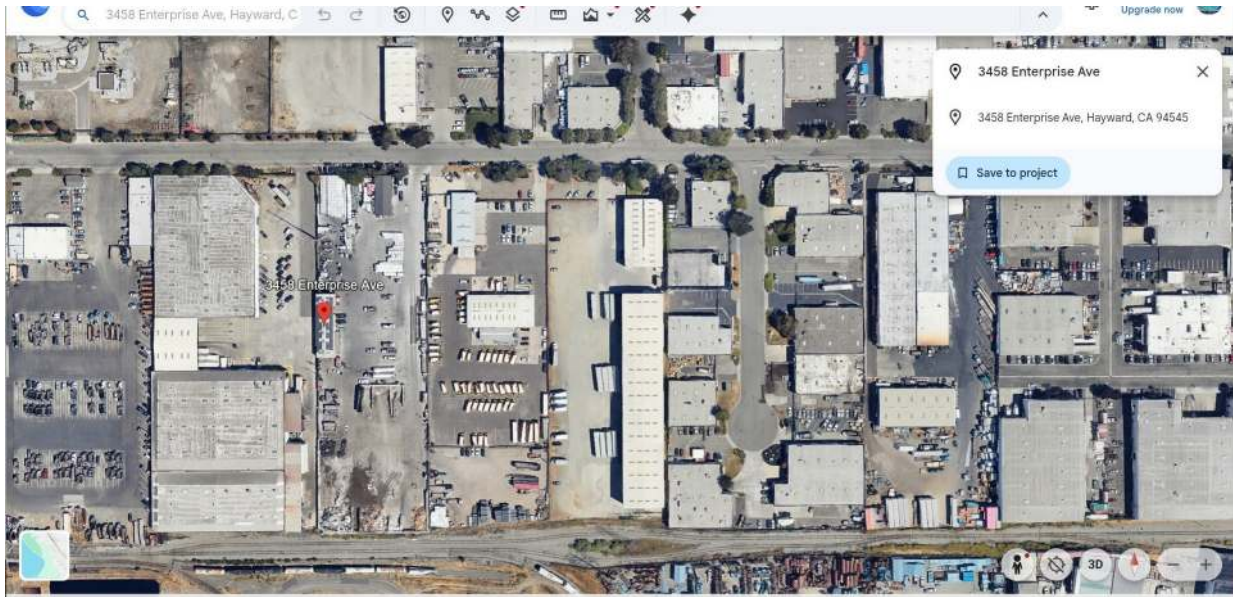
2231 La Mirada Dr., Vista (San Diego County) — active Reliable Onsite porta-potty yard. No fixed bulk-storage tank.



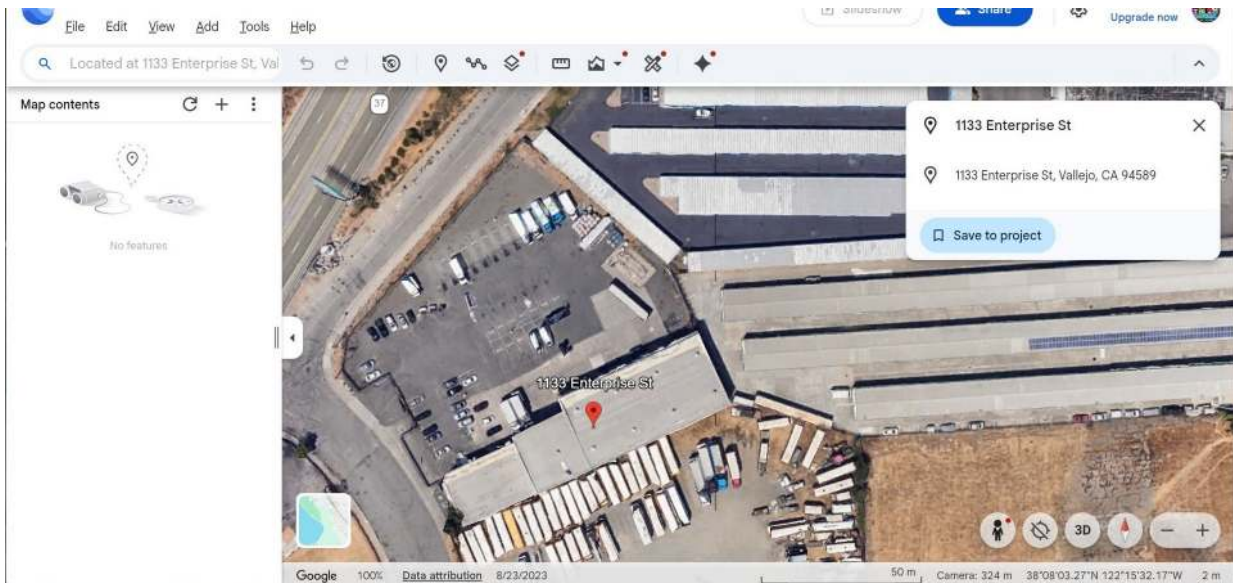

Why is that — and what it means.

A national operator does not decline to use a piece of equipment at dozens of its yards if that equipment were a normal, useful, and safe part of the business. The absence of the tank everywhere else is evidence that the tank is not an operational necessity — it is not how this business is run. Its presence at 6144 Federal Boulevard alone therefore reflects a deliberate, location-specific choice to hold septage in bulk here, and to impose the septicity hazard that comes with it on this community and nowhere else in the company's California operations.

That is the heart of the concern. The risk that a fixed septage tank creates — toxic, flammable, and corrosive conditions from waste held until it sours — is a risk United Rentals itself has judged unnecessary at every other yard it runs. It should not be borne by the residents and businesses beside 6144 Federal Boulevard either.

Relief the record supports.

On this record, I respectfully submit that the County — or any other agency with jurisdiction and authority to do so — should require United Rentals / Reliable Onsite Services to **immediately cease** the fixed FRAC-tank storage and transfer of septage at 6144 Federal Boulevard, an operation the County Sewage Hauler Permit (LSHOP-000063) does not authorize in any event (that permit authorizes portable-restroom cleaning and disposal at Pump Station #1 and OCSD Fountain Valley, and nothing more). Should the operator decline to comply with such a directive, continued operation should be treated as grounds for enforcement up to and including revocation of its permit. The company operates every other yard in California without this tank; **it can — and must — operate this one the same way.**

QUESTIONS RAISED ACROSS ALL 4 EXHIBITS

Weighing Exhibits A, B, C and D together

While there are more detailed issues raised within the individual exhibits, this section looks at what is left to be determined when the combined effects of all four exhibits are considered together — the video log of the operation as it actually runs (Exhibit A), the City of El Cajon's billing and disposal records (Exhibit B), what United Rentals told the City of San Diego's stormwater inspector (Exhibit C), and the statewide survey showing this fixed bulk-storage tank at 6144 Federal Boulevard and at no other United Rentals yard in California (Exhibit D). The questions that follow are placed here, at the end, because they turn on the exhibits read together — and, in the end, on whether the permitting under which this entire operation runs means anything at all.

1. In light of the fact that the video log documents United Rentals operating the FRAC tank at all hours of the day and night, seven days a week, including before dawn (**EX A, Video Log, Pg's 0010-0012**); that the City of El Cajon's own records show continuous, gallon-metered disposal in every one of 43 consecutive months, December 2022 through June 2026 (**EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-4, Pg's 0029-0072; EX-7, Pg 0111**); that United Rentals represented to the City of San Diego's stormwater inspector that the FRAC tank was used only for “large events” (**EX C, De Curtins / Wirschem Email, Pg's 0124-0125**); and that a survey of United Rentals' yards across California shows this fixed bulk-storage tank at 6144 Federal Boulevard and at no other yard (**EX D, California Yard Survey, Pg's 0127-0136**) — can that representation, and this one-of-a-kind operation, be reconciled with the record these four exhibits make together?

A second question runs through the permits themselves. United Rentals filed two sworn permit applications for one operation — all of it servicing the same yard at 6144 Federal Boulevard — yet the two do not describe the same fleet. The County DEHQ Sewage Hauler Permit (LSHOP-000063) lists nine vehicles; the City of El Cajon discharge permit lists twelve. Seven appear on both; five El Cajon-listed vehicles carry no County decal at all; and two County-permitted vehicles appear nowhere on El Cajon's roster. The one record that would show which vehicles actually hauled and discharged this waste, truck by truck — the City's Septic Station Sign-In Sheets — has been withheld.

2. In light of the fact that United Rentals' County permit lists nine vehicles while its El Cajon permit lists twelve, for one operation with all septage originating at the same 6144 Federal Blvd. yard — five El Cajon-listed vehicles carrying no County registration, and two County-permitted vehicles absent from El Cajon's records (**EX B, El Cajon Production Records at EX-2, Pg 0023; EX-3, Pg 0028**) — and that the Septic Station Sign-In Sheets that would identify each disposal by vehicle have been withheld, will the agencies compel production of those truck-by-truck records and determine which vehicles lawfully hauled this septage, and under what authority? If two sworn applications for the same operation cannot be reconciled as to the very fleet that performs it, what integrity remains in the permitting itself?

These questions, like those presented within Exhibit B, are posed for the record and not as conclusions. They rest on facts drawn from the agencies' own records and from my own contemporaneous documentation, and they are ones the agencies are positioned to resolve. I ask only that the answers — or their absence — be made part of the record in PRA 26-3709.
