Re: Supplement to my August 31, 2026 Report & Request for Reply — United Rentals (North America), Inc., dba Reliable Onsite Services (County Sewage Hauler Operating Permit No. LSHOP-000063; 6144 Federal Boulevard, San Diego): the City of El Cajon's own ordinances and permit records.

Dear District Attorney Stephan:

This letter supplements the Report and Request for Reply I submitted to your office on August 31, 2026. After that Report was submitted, the City of El Cajon completed its production of records responsive to my California Public Records Act requests Nos. 26-679, 26-690, and 26-583. That production was substantial: it arrived as twenty separate electronic archives totaling roughly 1.25 gigabytes and comprising more than 900 individual records — nearly 1,900 pages of the City's discharge permits, daily station sign-in logs, billing for this account, governing ordinances, and related correspondence. I have reviewed it in full. This supplement is necessary because that volume of the City's own records — produced only after my Report — both confirms and materially extends what the Report could show. Those records are the City's own; the exhibits to this supplement are drawn from them: Exhibit 1 is the City's ordinances, and Exhibit 2 is the City's records, Bates-stamped as cited below.

The purpose of this supplement is to show, from El Cajon's own records, how long this has been going on. Those records establish that for years — beginning with its first paperwork in August 2020 — United Rentals has disposed at the City's septage station at 1050 Vernon Way in a manner the City's own ordinances do not permit, under a City that did not enforce the rules it wrote. This is not a single lapse; it is a sustained course of conduct, and the City's records date it. And because neither United Rentals nor the City ever tested or recorded the pH or composition of these discharges, the environmental cost has accrued the entire time without anyone measuring it.

These records establish the duration of the pattern beyond what my August 31 Report could show, and they make one thing clear: the operation the community now confronts — the 40,000-gallon open-top FRAC tank and the bulk-transfer truck that empties it — did not

begin this. By the time that FRAC tank appeared, in 2024, the pattern was already years old and unpoliced; the FRAC tank only scaled it up.

1. El Cajon’s septage framework is two ordinances and one acceptance memo — and the City produced them as its own authority.

Disposal at the City’s septage station, 1050 Vernon Way, is governed by El Cajon Municipal Code Chapter 13.41 (“Septic Tank Waste Disposal”). Ordinance No. 3191 (adopted January 31, 1978) created that chapter: it designates 1050 Vernon Way as the authorized site for “septic tank waste material,” prohibits disposal without a permit, and authorizes the Director of Public Works to issue an annual permit for each vehicle, each vehicle to be “identified by California Vehicle License Number,” at a fee tied to tank capacity (Ex. 1, EX1-0001). Ordinance No. 4167 (adopted May 23, 1989) amended § 13.41.030 to require that a permit “identify each vehicle to be used by California vehicle license number and tank capacity” (Ex. 1, EX1-0003).

Separately, the City’s Industrial Waste Acknowledgement (Public Works, effective July 31, 2017) — which describes 1050 Vernon Way as a “residential waste dumping facility” — bars wastehaulers from dumping material that produces “toxic, corrosive, explosive and malodorous gases¹,” or with a pH “less than 5.5 or greater than 9.0,” and provides that the hauler’s permit is revoked if it violates those terms (Ex. 1, EX1-0006). These are the City’s complete local rules for the site, and the City produced them, in response to my requests, as its authority for accepting this waste. (PRR 26-690, items 7 and 8.)

2. United Rentals has been a permitted El Cajon hauler since 2020 — under permits that place responsibility for the material on the hauler.

The permit is not a City Council approval. Section 13.41.030 vests the decision in the Director of Public Works, who issues an annual, per-vehicle permit on an application listing each truck by license number and tank capacity; a hauler does not appear before the Council. The City’s records date United Rentals’ relationship with the site from the start. On August 14, 2020, United Rentals’ own Environmental Manager, Jeffrey Walker, signed the City’s Industrial Waste Acknowledgement for the business “United Rentals (North America), Inc., dba Reliable Onsite Services” (Ex. 2, EX2-0001). Six weeks later, on September 25, 2020, the City issued United Rentals Discharge Permit No. 20-01 (Ex. 2, EX2-0002), and it reissued that permit across 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2025 (Ex. 2, EX2-0002 through EX2-0007).

Every one of those permits, and the acknowledgement they incorporate, places the duty to keep each load within the City’s limits — pH 5.5 to 9.0, and no gas-producing or malodorous material — on the hauler, on pain of permit revocation. United Rentals accepted that duty in writing twice: Walker on August 14, 2020 (Ex. 2, EX2-0001), and Branch Manager David Perez on September 2, 2025 (Ex. 2, EX2-0008). It was thus a permitted hauler for nearly six

years — but the permit was United Rentals’ own certification, on the City’s form, that it would abide by the City’s conditions. (PRR 26-690, items 1 and 8.)

3. The permits were issued on a basis the ordinances do not allow — and by 2022 United Rentals’ own permits identified out-of-state trucks.

Chapter 13.41 requires each permitted vehicle to be identified “by California vehicle license number” — twice, in 1978 and again in 1989 (Ex. 1, EX1-0001; Ex. 1, EX1-0003). United Rentals’ original 2020 permit listed two California-plated trucks (Ex. 2, EX2-0002). Its own later permits did not:

- In 2022, on its April 6, 2022 permit, United Rentals listed a Mack bearing Indiana plate 3284107 (Ex. 2, EX2-0004).
- In 2023, on its January 17, 2023 permit, it listed a Mack bearing Indiana plate 3482510 (Ex. 2, EX2-0005).
- By 2025, on its April 23, 2025 fleet sheet — the one permit document with a state column — eleven of United Rentals’ twelve vehicles were Indiana-plated (Ex. 2, EX2-0007).

So beginning in 2022, on the face of its own permit applications, United Rentals identified its vehicles by out-of-state license number, which § 13.41.030 does not allow; the City issued and renewed the permits anyway. The City’s daily sign-in logs confirm the trucks that actually discharged were Indiana-plated throughout (Ex. 2, EX2-0012 through EX2-0015), and United Rentals’ County permit applications describe the same fleet as “registered through the State of IN at a corporate level” (my August 31, 2026 Report, Exhibit 2, p. 041). Two further mismatches appear on the same records: the site is authorized only for “septic tank waste,” while United Rentals hauls porta-potty and chemical-toilet waste; and El Cajon Municipal Code § 13.20.130 requires City Council authorization to accept sewage generated outside the City, for which the City produced no record. (PRR 26-690, item 1, and items 2 and 13 — none; PRR 26-679, item 5.)

4. The bulk-transfer truck discharged for nearly two years before the City permitted it — and the volume predates both the truck and the tank.

The City’s daily sign-in logs show the bulk-transfer truck — a 2023 Peterbilt, Indiana plate 3533049, 4,000-gallon capacity, driver “Marco” — first discharging at 1050 Vernon Way on July 20, 2023, four times that day (Ex. 2, EX2-0014). That truck appears on no El Cajon permit until the April 23, 2025, fleet sheet (Ex. 2, EX2-0007) — roughly twenty-one months of daily bulk discharge by a truck the City had never permitted.

But the volume did not begin with that truck. The City’s billing shows United Rentals already averaging about 77,000 gallons a month in the seven months before it (December 2022 through June 2023), rising to about 106,000 gallons a month once the truck was running, and about 144,000 gallons a month after the FRAC tank appeared in 2024 — roughly 5.4 million gallons billed from December 2022 through June 2026, and more once the 2020–2022

discharge the sign-in logs show is added. The logs document United Rentals discharging at 1050 Vernon Way as early as November 25, 2020 (Ex. 2, EX2-0012). The pattern is years older than the record before you showed, and the tank only scaled it up. (PRR 26-583; PRR 26-679 / 26-690, item 5.)

5. No one tested or recorded what went in — and United Rentals had signed that this was its responsibility.

Section 9 of my August 31 Report put a question before your office: nine days after a County inspection, United Rentals’ branch manager, David Perez emailed the El Cajon station to ask whether it tests what it receives (Ex. 2, EX2-0011), and the City’s Deputy Director of Public Works answered, in writing, that it does not, and that any questionable or industrial-strength load should go elsewhere (my August 31 Report, Exhibit 2). El Cajon’s production answers what my Report could only ask: United Rentals did not need to ask, because it had twice signed the City’s Industrial Waste Acknowledgement accepting that very duty (Ex. 2, EX2-0001; Ex. 2, EX2-0008). By signing — twice — United Rentals recognized this as ‘their’ responsibility: the obligation to keep each load within the City’s limits was United Rentals’ own, undertaken in writing, and not a duty the City had assumed on its behalf.

Nothing in the City’s process ever qualified what was actually discharged — the daily sign-in sheet records only date, time, company, plate, tank capacity, and driver, never the contents of the load (Ex. 2, EX2-0012 through EX2-0015) — and the City holds no responsive records of any pH or constituent testing of this account, no standard procedure for screening what it accepts, and no load rejection, surcharge, or notice of violation ever issued to United Rentals (PRR 26-690, items 9, 10, and 11 — none). This is where the environmental cost has accrued, unmeasured, the entire time. The single condition the surrounding community has reported first-hand — the odor at the 40,000-gallon FRAC tank — is, in the City’s own acceptance criteria, a prohibited “malodorous gas”: an odor is, by definition, gas coming off the material (Ex. 1, EX1-0006). United Rentals signed, twice, that it would not discharge material producing such gases. Yet across roughly 5.4 million gallons of billed discharge, neither United Rentals nor the City measured a single load against the limits United Rentals acknowledged.

6. Sign in Sheets

What can be seen by the records that with the number of trucks being reduced once the BT truck began operations the number of UR employees who made these discharges with septage pulled from the FRAC tank was drastically reduced to just a few employees.

The record shows that UR’s employees who signed the EC Dailies for the BT truck discharges were just two men across the entire period:

- Marco, who signed the discharges in 2023 and 2024 and again from the fall of 2025 through 2026
- Carlos V., who signed them through most of 2025 (Ex. 2, EX2-0014, EX2-0016, and EX2-0017, and passim in the daily sign-in logs).

Throughout, the bulk discharges were made by a 4,000-gallon bulk-transfer truck that appears in the logs under two license plates over time — Indiana plate 3533049, the 2023 Peterbilt listed on United Rentals' April 2025 fleet sheet (Ex. 2, EX2-0007), through the summer of 2025, and then plate 95407F4 (Ex. 2, EX2-0017) from mid-2025 onward. The two plates never appear on the same day, indicating a single bulk truck in service at a time. Plate 95407F4 appears on no El Cajon permit the City produced, and its state of registration is nowhere shown in the City's records.

I am not making any accusations as to these employees involvement in the septage discharge compliance standards being met, but what I do believe is worth knowing is who gave them their instructions and what, if any, procedures were in place that would have been UR's attempt to qualify these bulk transfer loads as being within the legal limits before they were discharged. I add one first-hand observation bearing on that same question of procedure and safety: despite the gaseous odors emanating from the FRAC tank, I never observed any United Rentals employee wearing personal protective equipment during these operations.

Conclusion.

I submit this as a supplemental report, to complete the record with the City of El Cajon's own documents — records the City produced after my August 31, 2026, Report. Together they establish that United Rentals disposed of millions of gallons of septage at the El Cajon station, beginning in December 2022 and continuing through the present, under permits whose terms it did not observe and against acceptance criteria the City never once measured.

I raise one further point deliberately, because these City records bear directly on a matter already before your office and I want to be clear that I am mindful of it: the disposal these El Cajon records date and quantify is the same disposal that United Rentals' own County Sewage Hauler Operating Permit applications — signed under penalty of perjury — did not disclose. As set out in my August 31, 2026 Report (Exhibit 2), those County applications named PS-1 (San Diego Metropolitan) and Fountain Valley as United Rentals' disposal destinations; the first County application to name El Cajon at all was signed December 11, 2025 — roughly three years after the City's own records show El Cajon disposal had begun. I do not characterize that discrepancy here; I flag it because the City's records now place it squarely on the documentary record, and your office should have the complete picture in evaluating it.

I offer one measured observation, meant to frame the record rather than to characterize it: these are the records of a company that did not observe the rules two public agencies — the County of San Diego and the City of El Cajon — set for exactly this activity, and because no one ever measured what was discharged, the cost of that disregard has fallen where it always does, on the environment and on the residents and businesses nearest the site. I remain available to provide any of the underlying records, and I respectfully renew the request for reply set out in my August 31, 2026, Report.

ECMC Ch. 13.41 — Ordinances 3191 (1978) & 4167 (1989); Industrial Waste Acknowledgement (2017)

Bates EX1-0001 – EX1-0006

ORDINANCE NO. 3191

AN ORDINANCE ADDING CHAPTER 13.41 TO TITLE 13 OF THE EL CAJON MUNICIPAL CODE TO ESTABLISH REQUIREMENT OF PERMITS AND FEES FOR UTILIZATION OF THE CITY'S SEPTIC TANK WASTE DISPOSAL SITE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL CAJON DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That Chapter 13.41 is hereby added to Title 13 of the El Cajon Municipal Code, to read as follows:

"CHAPTER 13.41

SEPTIC TANK WASTE DISPOSAL

§13.41.010 City Septic Tank Waste Disposal Site.

The septic tank waste disposal site located at 1050 Vernon Way in the City of El Cajon is designated as the authorized site for disposal of septic tank waste material into the city sewer system.

§13.41.020 Unauthorized Disposal Prohibited.

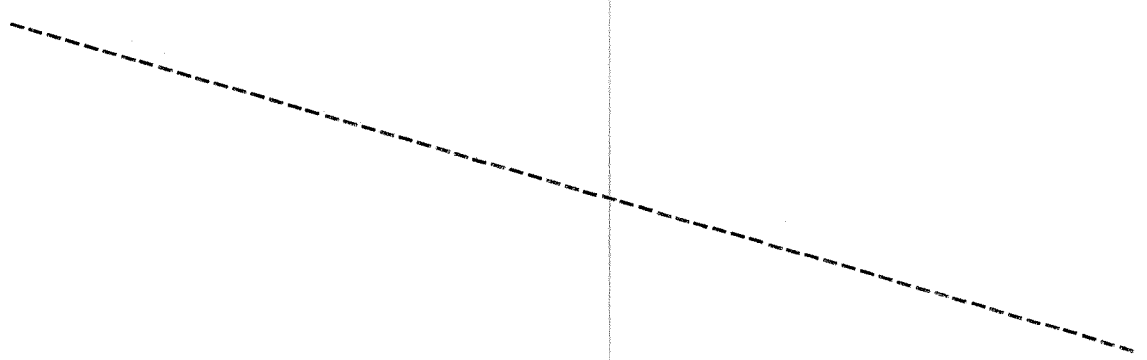
No person shall discharge septic tank waste into the city sewer system at any location within the city other than at the disposal site specified in §13.41.010, and no person shall discharge septic tank waste at said site without having first obtained the permit and paid the fees prescribed by §13.41.030.

§13.41.030 Permits and Fees.

The Director of Public Works is authorized to issue permits for discharge at the city disposal site. Said permits shall authorize discharge for a period of one year, and may be issued for an individual vehicle, which shall be identified by California Vehicle License Number on the permit. The permit shall be kept in the vehicle and presented upon demand when discharging at the city site.

The fees for said permits shall be based upon the capacity of each vehicle at the rate of \$100.00 per 1000 gallons of sewage capacity per vehicle. Said fees shall be deposited in the sanitation fund established pursuant to §13.44.010."

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be effective thirty days following its passage and adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 4167

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 13.41.030 OF
CHAPTER 13.41 OF THE EL CAJON MUNICIPAL CODE
TO REVISE FEES FOR DISCHARGE OF SEPTIC TANK WASTE

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it advisable to adjust the annual fees for discharge of septic tank waste into the authorized septic tank waste disposal site located at 1050 Vernon Way in the City of El Cajon.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL CAJON DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That Section 13.41.030 of Chapter 13.41 (Septic Tank Waste Disposal) of the El Cajon Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"13.41.030 Permits and fees.

The director of public works is authorized to issue permits for discharge at the city disposal site, and establish regulations and procedures to be used. Said permits shall authorize discharge for a period of one year and may be issued to a person, entity, or business, which shall identify each vehicle to be used by California vehicle license number and tank capacity.

The fees for such permits shall be as follows:

- (a) An annual permit fee of \$100 per person, entity, or business;
- (b) An additional fee of \$1.50 per one hundred gallon capacity per discharged load.

The fees shall be deposited in the Sanitation Fund established pursuant to Section 13.44.010."

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be effective thirty days following its passage and adoption.
